### **Chatsworth Police Services Board**

The Township's three member Police Services Board is comprised of a Member of Council, a community representative as appointed by Township Council and a provincially appointed representative. The Board meets six (6) times per year; the third Monday of every other month. Board members receive an honorarium per meeting.

### **Fence Viewers**

Each Term of Office, the Township of Chatsworth Council appoints individuals to act as 'Fence Viewers'. Fence Viewers respond to calls from the Clerk's Office to resolve disputes regarding the placement of fences within the municipality in accordance with the Line Fences Act, R.S.O. 1990. Fence Viewers are responsible to examine premises by either adjoining landowner, hear evidence, and make an award respecting any dispute. The Fence Viewers role also includes, but is not limited to, determining the following;

- location of the fence;
- who shall construct the fence;
- the type of construction including the materials to be used;
- the date of completion;
- who shall be responsible for maintaining the fence;
- and shall state the percentage each owner is responsible for

All notices under the Act are sent out by the Clerk's Office. Fence-viewers receive an honorarium and mileage per occurrence.

### **Source Water Protection**

The Councils of the Municipalities that are within the grouping identified in Table A will submit a list of persons to the Drinking Water Source Protection Office. From this list the Management Committee will recommend a name to the Grey Sauble Source Protection Authority, which will appoint the new representative to the Source Protection Committee.
