ELECTION WORKERS NEEDED

The Township of Chatsworth is once again conducting the 2018 municipal election using the Vote By Mail method. As such, the Township of Chatsworth is seeking individuals to assist with the counting of ballots on Monday, October 22, 2018. Applicants must be available from 7:00 p.m. until the completion of the counting of ballots and must attend a training session of approximately 2 hours prior to that day.

If you are a candidate or the spouse of a candidate, or managing or actively involved in the campaign of a candidate, you are not eligible to work in the 2018 Municipal Election.

No experience is necessary; however past election experience is an asset. Training will be provided. Election workers must have their own transportation.

Pay rate of \$21.00 per hour includes mandatory attendance at one training session from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 25, 2018.

Please submit your interest in writing, indicating any previous election experience you might have. Election Workers must be 18 years of age or older. Contact information must be included in your submission.
