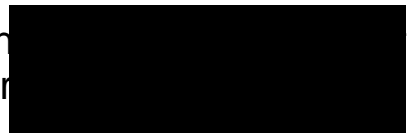


EVERY SECOND COUNTS!

Have a meeting outside your home.

Call 9-1-1 for your emergency number from outside the home.
