Prescribed Nomination forms and other candidate forms are to be filed with the Township of Chatsworth Clerk at the Municipal office located at 316837 Highway 6, Chatsworth, during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, commencing Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 until the closing of nominations at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 19, 2022 (Nomination Day).

The Term of Office for the offices listed above will be from November 15, 2022 to November 14, 2026.

Nomination papers for candidates are available at the Township Office or on the Township's website at [www.chatsworth.ca](http://www.chatsworth.ca). Candidates must submit the prescribed nomination and endorsement forms, proof of qualifying address and payment of the appropriate nomination filing fee in cash, debit, certified cheque or money order (made payable to the "Township of Chatsworth"). Nomination fees are as follows: \$200.00 for the office of Mayor and \$100.00 for all other offices.

No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for election purposes or incur campaign expenses until he or she has filed a nomination paper.
