

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATSWORTH

By-Law Number 2019-31

Being a By-law to Appoint Livestock Valuers

Whereas Section 4 of the Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act, R.S.O. 1990, requires the Council of every local municipality to appoint one or more persons as valuers of livestock and poultry; and


Whereas the Council of the Township of Chatsworth deems it expedient to appoint more than one Livestock Valuer;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chatsworth hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Brian Klages and Claire Halliday be appointed as Livestock Valuers for the 2018-2022 Council Term.
2. The remuneration to be paid by the Township to the Livestock Valuers shall be a rate of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per call plus mileage, at the Township's mileage allowance rate of the day, from the Livestock Valuers place of residence to the location of the Livestock Valuation and any other required location and return.
3. That if the provisions of this by-law conflict with any other by-laws previously passed then the provisions of this by-law shall prevail.
4. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect as of January 1, 2019.

Read a first and second time this 1st day of May, 2019

Read a third time, and finally passed this 1st day of May, 2019.
