#### 2022 Municipal Election

Have your say in the upcoming municipal and school board election on October 24, 2022. If you are a resident, owner or tenant of property, a Canadian citizen, and 18 years of age you can vote in the municipal and school board elections.

#### Updating Voting Information:

Have you moved or changed your address within Ontario in the last four years? Or do you have an adult child who no longer lives at home? Help us update our voters' list and check to see that you are on the list for the 2022 Municipal and School Board Elections by visiting [voterlookup.ca](http://voterlookup.ca). Check that your information is accurate. By having an up-to-date voters' list helps our election run smoothly, but also saves tax dollars in sending out unnecessary vote by mail packages.

Anyone proposing to be a candidate in the municipal election to be held on Monday, October 24, 2022, for the Township of Chatsworth may file a nomination form for the offices listed below.
