WINTER CONTROL SEASONAL OPERATORS AND WINTER PATROLLER

The Township of Chatsworth is seeking two seasonal equipment operators and a winter patroller for the 2023/2024 winter season, commencing November 13 – April 26.

Seasonal Operator

The successful candidate will perform winter control activities and general road maintenance throughout the Township. The ideal applicant will possess the following qualifications:

- Must hold a minimum DZ driver's license and have a clear Driver's Abstract
- Ability to operate and maintain a variety of heavy and medium equipment, vehicles and machinery used in municipal operations and maintenance functions
- Knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and the Highway Traffic Act
- Previous snow plowing experience is a definite asset

Winter Patroller

The successful candidate is responsible for patrolling and monitoring Township owned roads in accordance with minimum maintenance standards, weather conditions and forecasts. May also perform duties of a Plow Operator, if qualified, as needed.

Duties

- Inspect Township owned road patrol areas at the Provincially mandated frequency
- Calls out plow operators to maintain roads based on observed weather conditions and/or forecast
- Inspect for road/infrastructure deficiencies, including but not limited to snow/accumulation
- Snow removal from municipal parking lots
- Must complete daily logs and time sheets
- Night time shift hours are required including weekends

Requirements

- G License required (DZ License preferred) with clean driver's abstract
- Experience driving in adverse winter conditions
- Operation of a plow/sander unit an asset
- Good communication skills

Upon final selection the successful applicant(s) will be required to provide, at their own expense, a background check from the Ontario Provincial Police or appropriate police force, as well as a clean Driver's Abstract.
